


INDUS HOSPITAL COLLABORATES WITH HUNAR

KORANGI COMPLEX

The Hunar Foundation (THF) Institute at Korangi, Karachi is spread over 2.75 acres located at Ibrahim Hyderi Road, Korangi, Karachi. This complex includes both Boy's and Girl's Training Campuses as well as a Teachers Training Centre.

THF Korangi Complex envisions graduating over 2500 students across its 9 modules which will be offering trainings in various existing conventional trades as well as advance Technology trades such as Robotics, Mechatronics, Internet of Things, Advance Manufacturing and 3D Printing.

MUSTAFA KASSAM TEACHERS TRAINING INSTITUTE

Since there is a tremendous requirement for qualified trainers over the next decade, THF aims to introduce 'Train the Trainers' program for which two buildings within the Korangi Complex have been dedicated for the purpose of providing prospective and existing teachers with necessary skills and expertise to impart high quality training to students in the TVET sector.

100 GIRLS WILL GRADUATE

FROM ITS BEAUTY THERAPY COURSE IN 2021

For our vision of empowering women, The Hunar Foundation started its operations of Korangi Complex with its first female institute in the name of Saeeda Naseem Technical Institute which will be graduating 100 girls from its Beauty Therapy Course in 2021.

In the mission of skilling the marginalized youth the support of our esteemed donors have always been very encouraging without whom building A Skilled Pakistan would never have been possible.

THF is not only working for a Skilled Pakistan but also striving towards a clean and green Pakistan. Currently a Solar Energy System is being installed at THF Korangi Complex in Karachi and this conversion will immediately reduce the carbon footprint as well as reduce the monthly electricity expenses. Another Solar Energy System will be installed in THF Bedian Institute in Lahore in the coming months, made possible through the generous donation of Dr. Farouq Ahmed. For third world countries like Pakistan, that have unstable electrical grids, Solar Solutions provide continuous electricity amidst frequent power outages.

ONLINE EDUCATION:

Due to THF Institute lock-downs during COVID-19 pandemic THF implemented a mitigation strategy of delivering theoretical content online. The objective was the continuation of training programs through an online platform to reduce loss of studies, encourage effective communication, and to minimize student drop-outs when lock down is over.

THF Trustees and donors had engaged industry professionals to develop over 15,000 Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) for the safety and security of doctors and paramedic staff to take care of COVID-19 patients. MOTORCYCLE MAINTENANCE TRADE

Pakistan is the 5th largest motorcycle market in the world after China, India, Indonesia and Vietnam. Everyday 7,500 new motorcycles are sold putting Pakistan on the list for World's fastest growing two-wheeler market soaring at rates of over 20% a year.

Keeping in view this growing demand and anticipating the need for trained motorcycle repair mechanics, THF launched a new trade called Motorcycle Maintenance in THF Institutes in Lahore, Kharian and Karachi. The launch of this new trade was made possible by generous donations of Security Papers and Dr. Faroug Ahmed.

As soon she completed her Customer Service Representative course at Hunar in 3 months, she was offered a job at IBEX (Subsidiary of TRG International) and with her extra-ordinary performance was awarded "Exceptional Performer for the Quarter" award within just few months of her service.

Hafsa is earning Rs.25,000 with other perks and incentives offered by the company and is now able to pay medical bills of her retired and paralyzed father, making him proud.

SON OF A FARMER BECOMES A WORKSHOP OWNER

Achoo, belonged to a marginalized family living in the surroundings of Tando Allahyar and worked in the fields, but had a dream. Despite all the odds he had a goal to do something to share his father's financial burden and make him proud. Achoo came to know about The Hunar Foundation through a local newspaper which mentioned about Hunar, Rashidabad campus offering scholarships sponsored by OGDCL for various technical courses. He appeared for its entry test and enrolled in Motorcycle trade and successfully completed his six months diploma course.

After completion of course he worked at a repair workshop for a few months to develop hands-on knowledge and skills. He then started his own repair & maintenance Auto Workshop. With his earnings he now supports his family, at the same time has upgraded his workshop by adding tire puncture services and provision of spare parts to increase earnings. With a monthly income of Rs.40,000 approximately he has paid off his father's debt and helped him open a fruit stall at the corner of his workshop to keep him engaged.

Now he is proudly sharing his family's burden besides supporting few other families by hiring four workers at his workshop.
